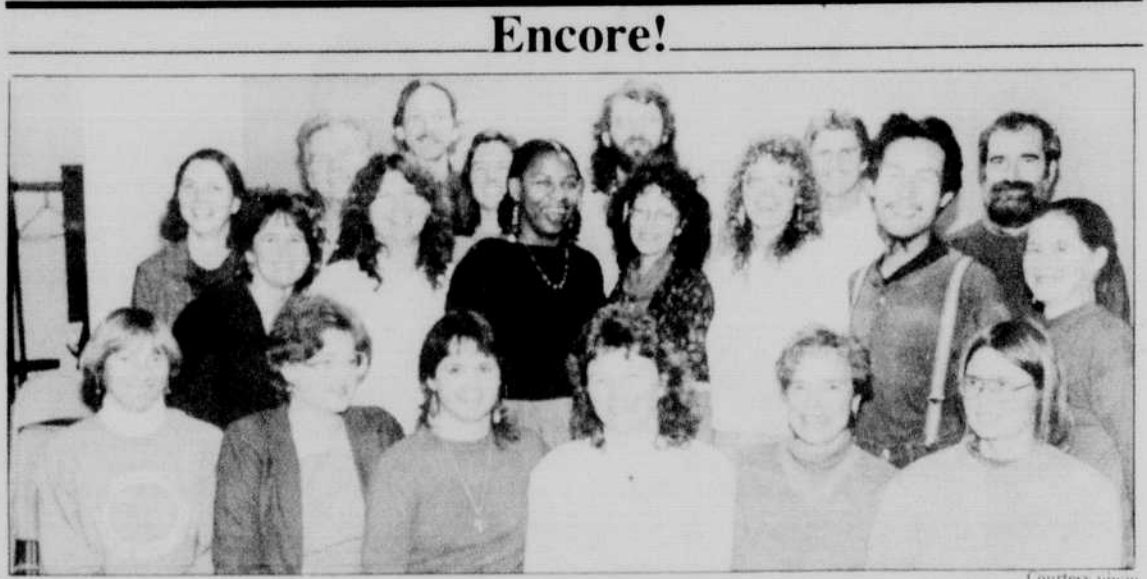

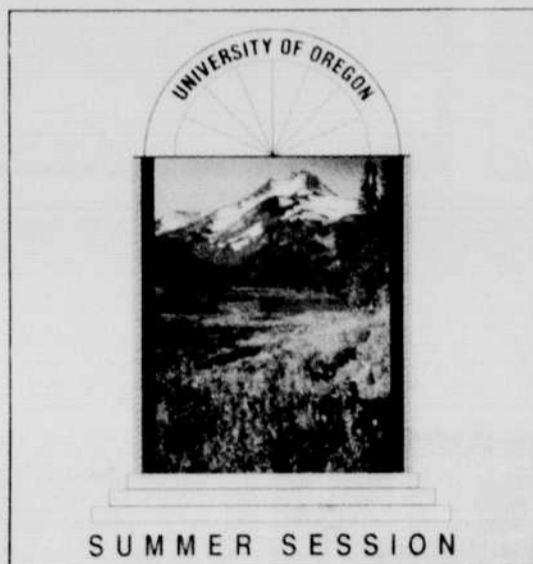
West Side Story will be at the Hult Center Silva Concert Hall tonight at 8. Tickets for this musical are priced from \$15 to \$25.
