No new entries in top ASUO race But competition is plentiful for IFC seats

Despite a last-minute flurry of campaign petitions, no new candidates have entered the race for student body president and vice president.

Two current members of the ASUO executive staff, University affairs coordinator Kirk Bailey and publicity coordinator Sheila Stickel, will face IFC member Steve Maples and his running mate Diane Cushman in the contest for student body president during the election primaries April 19 and 20.

Vice presidential candidate Cushman said that running against only one other party will not alter the campaign she and Maples planned.

"We planned to run our race the same way no matter if we were running unopposed or against one other candidate, or two or three," she said. "All it means is that it will be decided in the primaries."

Bailey said that he and Stickel also agreed that their campaign strategies would remain the same no matter how many parties entered the race.

"We were expecting the ticket to shape up the way it did," Bailey said. "We expect it to be a hotly contested race," he added.

For all elected posts to be decided this month, the elections board had received only 11 petitions before Friday, the closing day of the filing period. Most of the 29 petitions submitted Friday were for seats in the Student Senate or for spots on the IFC.

Twelve students are running for a total of six available IFC positions, including current member Freddy Vilches and former member Tim Hughes.

Seven students have entered the race for two

seats on the President's Advisory Committee.

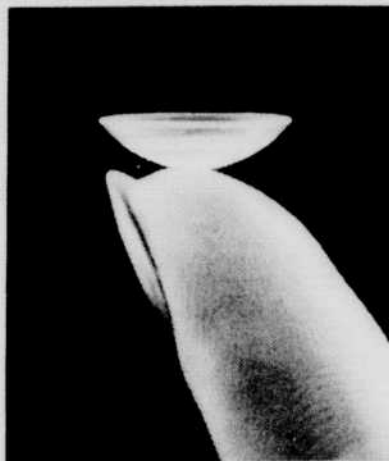
