

ready for this Saturday's scrimmage.

Although Kelemeni has more experience than Burwell, Burwell's performance has definitely made the tailback position one that will be competitive.

"Obviously he (Kelemeni) was the leading candidate," for the tailback position, Brooks said. "Sean Burwell had a good scrimmage and is a talented back. It will be a hotly contested position. Both tailbacks need to stay healthy and it might come down to who stays healthy."

Still, the future looks bright for Kelemeni, who does bring some traits — his size and speed — to the position that Loville, who was 5-10 and 198 pounds might not have had.

"I think I have more of a blend of quickness and power," Kelemeni said. "Derek was more of a quick back, but at the same time, he was still powerful."

Brooks said that the biggest difference between the two backs is their styles.

"I think he's a step faster," Brooks said of Kelemeni. "Loville had good quickness, but not great breakaway speed. Ngalu has good breakaway speed, but isn't as quick as Loville."

"Ngalu can't make the cuts that Derek was famous for because he's bigger and stronger. His style is different. He's not a quick-cutting, slashing back with one-cut explosiveness like Loville."

Loville also used his quick, cutting abilities to become a good receiver for Oregon as well, finishing his career with 92 receptions, 10th-most in school history. However, Brooks believes that Kelemeni could be just as good a receiver as Loville.

"I think Ngalu can be as productive (as Loville)," Brooks said. "His height will help him because a lot of the passes to running backs are short passes over the line."

Kelemeni might not be able to make people forget about Loville, but the Ducks are hoping he can lessen the blow of losing the best running back in school history.
