gars return Tony Li, who was fourth in the NCAA outdoor event last year and then captured the NCAA indoor 55-meter hurdles in March. Li owns a best of 13.68 in the 110 highs and will get a stiff test from Oregon's Bob Gray, who ran his second-fastest time ever last weekend (14.07).

The two best vaulters in the Pac-10 this season, Oregon's Brian Cullen and Washington State's Patrik Johannsson, will face off in the vault where Johannsson has won the two previous meetings. Cullen has cleared 17-7 this season outdoors while Johannsson scaled the same height indoors.

The Ducks two long jumpers, Latin Berry and Spencer Williams, will square off with George Ogebeide, a transfer from Idaho. Berry has barely jumped over 24 feet this season, but both he and Williams will have to be at their best to beat Ogebeide, who has a lifetime best of 26-8½.

Despite both teams' exceptional strength in several events, Dellinger said he doesn't believe the meet will hinge on any one event, citing last week's meet with Washington as a key example where the Ducks need every point they can get to win.

"Actually all of the points become important," he said. "When we're hoping for a third place so we can get one point in the high jump (or another event) we need to get those points to be in the position to win."

The men's meet begins at 12:30 p.m. with the hammer throw. The first running event will be the steeplechase at 1:30 p.m.
