Women sweep meets in festival of records

A bundle of personal records highlighted the return of the Oregon women's track team to winning ways Saturday at Hayward Field in a meet against Washington State and Boise State.

After their first loss to Washington in 12 years last week in Seattle, the motivated Ducks outscored a tough Cougar squad 79-57. Boise State, a team that was never really in the meet except for a few bright spots, was outscored by Oregon 93-42.

Sophomore Kim Hyatt and junior Paula Berry started things off on the winning track for Oregon by grabbing first and second in the javelin. The two Ducks provided the only real competition for each other in the meet, yet neither was pleased with her individual effort.

"I need a lot more consistency," Hyatt complained. "My rhythm was off."

"It's frustrating," Berry said of practicing hard and then performing below expectations in a meet. "Everyday we go out hard."

Junior Kamala Kohlmeier set the tone for the remainder of the meet by jumping 19-1/4 in

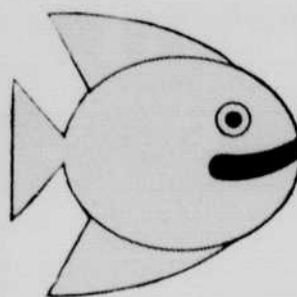
