

# Dead gray whale washes ashore on Northern Oregon coast

WARRENTON (AP) — An autopsy was planned on a 33-foot gray whale whose carcass was found washed ashore at Fort Stevens State Park about 1 1/2 miles south of the Peter Iredale shipwreck, assistant park manager Mike Barber said.

Members of the Northwest Marine Stranding Recovery Network studied the carcass Sunday.

John Ford, one of the team members, said the whale was a male, about 3 to 5 years old. The animal died during the spring migration period, when gray whales migrate north along the Pacific coast to Alaskan waters.

"There looked like there was some trauma around the head," Ford said. "He could have been hit by a

ship, but we won't know until the autopsy."

The autopsy will be conducted on site, probably about mid-week, he said.

Students from Portland State University, where the network is based, and possibly local high school students, will participate, he said.
