Duck women prepare for meet *Top athletes to compete*

The Oregon Invitational track and field meet is already under way with the heptathlon and decathlon starting Thursday and concluding today at Hayward Field.

The Oregon women's track team hopes to take advantage of a traditionally strong field of competitors, including athletes from more than 25 Northwest universities and colleges, as it looks to add more Pacific-10 Conference meet qualifiers and NCAA qualifiers.

The bulk of the events take place Saturday with the day meet running from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., and the twilight session beginning at 4:15.

Oregon freshman Kelly Blair,

the top high school heptathlete in the nation last year, will make her collegiate debut. The two-time TAC junior champion has competed in only three of the seven heptathlon events this year because of her earlier commitment to the basketball team.

"This whole year for Kelly is a matter of getting perspective," said Oregon coach Tom Heinonen, regarding Blair's double duties with track and basketball.

Heinonen sees no problem in Blair qualifying for the Pac-10 meet. The qualifying mark of 4,500 points is far below Blair's best of 5,231, which she achieved in 1988. Her best mark last year was 5,152.

Most of Oregon's athletes will compete Saturday, but four athletes are in Des Moines, Iowa, competing today and Saturday in the Drake Relays.

Senior Liz Wilson, sophomores Carol Holmen and Kim Hutson, and freshman Erika Klein traveled to the Midwest

with Heinonen for the 81st annual event, marking the first time an Oregon athlete has made the trip since 1960.

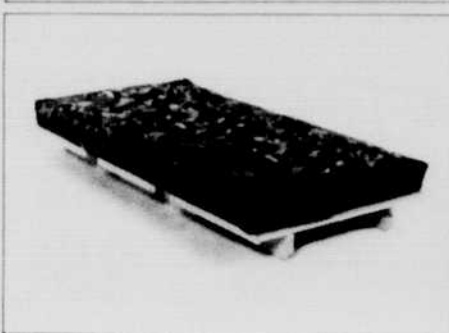
