The biggest surprise of the meet was Oliver who is redshirting for Oregon this season.

Oliver is a junior college transfer from Glendale College in Phoenix, Ariz., who has been going through spring drills with the football team as a cornerback. He had been held out of contact drills in football because of a broken wrist, and competed in his first track meet Saturday since an indoor meet in January.

But Oliver, whose speciality

is the decathlon, looked like he had been in track all spring when he cleared 7-0½ to win the competition over former Duck Andy Young, the school record holder.

"It's been real frustrating," said Oliver who jumped with a light cast on his left wrist. "trying to go all out in football and having to redshirt in track. I had no idea what to expect today."

Oliver said that of the two sports, track is "definitely the favorite."

"Track and field marks speak for themselves," he said. "If you jump 7-5 in the high jump, you're a 7-5 high jumper. You can't really judge in football. If you're a cornerback they judge you based on interceptions and that's not always right."

While Oliver has to wait a year for the decathlon, Oregon's Pedro daSilva and Mike Leonesio competed in the multi-event competition on Thursday and Friday.

DaSilva scored 7,818 points to easily win the competition and surpass the NCAA qualifying standard of 7,480. It was also daSilva's second best score as a Duck. Leonesio finished second with 7,007 points to narrowly pass the Pacific-10 Conference standard of 7,000.

Eric Peterson fell just short in his bid to qualify in the 1,500 meters finishing in 3:44.06 after teammate Danny Lopez went out to quicken the pace in

the first 1,200 meters. However, the most significant performance in the 1,500 might have belonged to Alan Foster.

After qualifying for the NCAA in the 1,500 last season, Foster has been beset by injuries this season and had been struggling. On Saturday though Foster showed he isn't finished by clocking 3:47.76 to qualify for the Pac-10 meet.

Also turning in impressive

performances were four Oregon runners in the 5,000.

Peter Fonseca won the event in 14:04.59, his best time ever while teammates Pat Haller (14:11.83), Rick Mestler (14:12.10) and Steve Richards (14:24.67) all ran PR times as well.

The javelin and 110-meter hurdles were also stellar events.

Brian Crouser, who set the

Hayward Field record of 261-0 last year, won the event with a throw of 255-8 while New York Athletic Club teammate Mike Barnett tossed 244-3. Oregon's Art Skipper was third, throwing 236-2.

In the 110 hurdles, Patrick Duffy won the event in 13.75, the only other meet record while Oregon's Bob Gray was second in 14.03. It was Gray's second-fastest time ever.
