

Oregon golf team places sixth at Pac-10 tourney

Senior Tim Hval finished in a tie for 14th Sunday at the Pacific-10 Conference golf men's championships in Tempe, Ariz., helping the Ducks to a sixth-place finish in the team competition.

Hval shot a 293 for four rounds at Karsten Golf Course, 15 shots behind Arizona State's Phil Mickelson. Mickelson shot a 10-under-par 278 to edge teammate Scott Frisch for medalist honors.

Chris Holzgang, also a senior, tied for 20th with a score of 298 as the Ducks' second highest finisher. Hval and Holzgang were named to the second-team all-conference squad, while teammate Tom Smith was given honorable mention honors.

Smith finished in a tie for 27th with a 302 for the four rounds. Bob Rannow and Mark Aldrich each shot a 307 to tie for 39th, and Cam Martin scored a 313 to notch a tie for 45th to round out the Duck scoring.

The Sun Devils ran away with the team competition leaving runner-up Arizona 54 strokes back. Mickelson was selected as the league player of the year while ASU coach Steve Loy was honored as coach of the year.

Oregon must now wait for the May 21 announcement of bids for the NCAA West Regional scheduled for May 24-26 at New Mexico State. Oregon made it to regional competition last year.

The top finisher of the regional tournament qualifies for the NCAA Championships on June 6-9 at Tarpon Springs, Fla.

Women

The Oregon women's golf team finished sixth at the Pacific-10 Conference championships Sunday marking the school's best finish ever at the tournament.

The Ducks accumulated a 939 in the three-day, 54-hole tournament. Oregon had finished seventh twice and ninth once in its other previous showings.

Starla Yamada tied for 17th with a 232 as Oregon's top finisher. Nancy Crawford was three shots back of her teammate to tie for 22nd.

Arizona State's Brandie Burton shot a 5-under-par 214 to finish four strokes ahead of Martina Koch of Arizona. UCLA took home the team title compiling an 898. The score bested runner-up Arizona by one stroke and third-place finisher ASU by two strokes.

Other Oregon scores include Leigh Hornung's 236 for a tie for 25th, Shannon Maier's 239 to tie for 32nd, and Anna Pianalto's 245 which netted her 37th place.
