from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., participants will be given a schedule of events and a map of the sites to be renovated. People will then be separated into four different groups: pressure washing, painting, landscape and litter patrol, Sandy said.

The tasks will be primarily centered in the Knight Library/Memorial Quadrangle area and, depending on the number of people, some groups will spread out to the EMU grounds and the area between Fenton and Villard halls, Untalan said.

Volunteers will work from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. The day's activities will end up with an ice cream social and a free concert featuring rhythm and blues act The Blubinos.

Highlights of University Day include a tree planting in front of Fenton Hall, to replace a tree that was blown down winter term and to make tribute to the Class of 1990, Untalan said. There will also be repainting

done on the huge landmark "O" on the side of Skinner's Butte.

Although the event is mostly coordinated by students, Sandy said the committee has received support from the administration as well.

Marcia Daneb, assistant director of the news bureau, said she has been the official link between the students and the media.

"I've been working with radio, T.V. and newspapers to cover the actual event," Daneb said, adding that radio station KUGN will be broadcasting the occasion.

The Physical Plant has donated tools and other supplies that may be needed, said Ted Burns, assistant director of the Physical Plant.

A second informational meeting on University Day will be held May 9 at 5:00 p.m. in the Ben Linder Room.
