

ball move well," Brown said. "I asked her how she was doing and she said fine. Usually she'll say if she's tired."

Brown said changes on the team helped the Ducks on defense, partly because of changed attitudes.

"We just made some team changes and the kids felt better with who they were playing around," Brown said.

Sophomore shortstop Danny Senner, who was all Pac-10 her freshman year, left the team earlier in the week due to what

Brown called "differences with the team." Brown said what was left of the Oregon infield was a big key in the win.

"Kim Manning is a great shortstop," Brown said. "She did a great job. She's our leader, she talks and she has great lateral mobility. Okuhara is a good third baseman and Ces (Coulson) has done a great job at second."

Oregon got all the scoring it would need in the fifth inning when Okuhara scored from third after an errant pickoff at-

tempt from catcher Val Altamirano. Okuhara led off the inning with a single to center field and went to third on Coulson's sacrifice bunt. Julie Cavanaugh grounded to second to move Okuhara to third.

With Oregon outfielder Jeanna King at the plate, Altamirano tried to pick off Okuhara, who had a lead from the bag. But her throw went into left field where Cal's Tina Montoya bobbed it, allowing Okuhara to come home.

"If the left fielder hadn't bob-

bled it, I wouldn't have sent her because she would have been nailed at home," said Brown, who was coaching third base when the play happened. "She listened very well and did a great job."

Okuhara said she listened to Brown all the way.

"I wouldn't have scored unless the coach had said go," Okuhara said. "I saw her bobble it. If she had gotten the throw off there's no way I would have scored."

Oregon has four more games remaining on its regular-season schedule — all with Pac-10 softball doormat Oregon State. If the Ducks can sweep all four, they would finish 35-21 on the season. Brown said that could be good enough for post-season play.

"We have a good shot at post-season play," Brown said. "Cal was eighth in the nation and we beat Arizona State at 12th. The loss to Portland State could hurt us, but beating Cal twice in the Pac-10 will help."

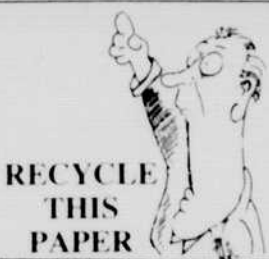
