State ed system fills two posts

Academic, finance jobs filled last week

The Oregon State System of Higher Education has filled two positions with members of the administrations of the University of Minnesota and Ohio State University, respectively.

Chancellor Thomas Bartlett announced last week that Shirley Clark, former acting vice president for academic affairs and acting provost at Minnesota, has accepted the position as vice chancellor for academic affairs.

Also, Weldon Ihrig, former vice president of finance at Ohio State, will become vice chancellor for finance and administration for the state system August 1.

Clark will succeed interim vice chancellors Robert Frank, from Oregon State University, and the late Richard Hill, a former University provost. She holds a doctoral degree in sociology from Ohio State.

"Oregon is fortunate to gain someone with Shirley Clark's reputation for institutional leadership and for academic leadership," Bartlett said in a press release.

"Getting Shirley Clark is comparable to a major league contender signing a first round draft choice," said board member Rob Miller, chairman of the board's instruction committee, also in a press release.

"The good news is we were lucky she signed," he said.

Clark has taught in Minnesota's departments of sociology and educational policy and administration since 1968. She has published widely about education and youth, including a 1985 book written with Darrell Lewis entitled, *Faculty Vitality and Institutional Policy*.

Ihrig has held various administrative positions at Ohio State since 1965. He will replace W. T. Lemman, who is retiring after 40 years as a state system administrator.

"We are fortunate to attract

someone with the national professional stature and depth of experience of Weldon Ihrig," Bartlett said.

Ihrig will be responsible, among other things, for preparing, administering, and monitoring the state system's \$2.1 billion biennial budget. He will also be responsible for personnel and benefits management for the state's 16,000 employees.

Ihrig holds a master of business administration degree as well as a bachelor of electrical engineering degree from Ohio State. He is a member of the National Association of College and University Business Officers.
