percent recycled product made in the United States instead of helping Germany with their disposal problem." Merritt said

At first, a U.S. plant will struggle to sell the product because of its different look than first-use bleached paper, he said. Recycled paper also leaves dust behind in printing presses and copying machines. raising maintenance costs, he said

However, even with all these problems, the paper will sell, he said.

"It's almost a badge of honor when you use recycled paper,"he said.

Daniel Jerrems, president of the Atlantic Recycled Paper Company, said the German paper is "hot stuff."

'We're selling it as fast as we get it, ... even though the price is 10 percent higher (than firstuse paper), he said.
