

Berry, Brandon get top honors

Terrell Brandon and Paula Berry were named Sunday as the Oregon Daily Emerald men's and women's athletes of the year.

Brandon, who was a unanimous selection by the Emerald sports staff, averaged 17.9 points and had a school record for a sophomore with 174 assists on the season to lead the Ducks to a 15-14 overall record and an appearance in the National Invitational Tournament.

Brandon became Oregon's third sophomore in modern times to be named to the Pacific-10 all-conference squad, joining Ron Lee and Blair Ras-

mussen in that distinction.

The 5-foot-11 Brandon led the team in scoring 14 times while ranking second on nine occasions. He finished among the conference leaders in four categories.

Berry, a junior on the Oregon women's track team, had a personal record of 178-1 in the javelin at the Pac-10 meet May 19 in Seattle to qualify for last week's NCAA meet in Durham, N.C., where she placed second with a throw of 174-9.

Berry, who attended Dayville High School, qualified for the NCAA meet in her freshman year, but had an off year in her

sophomore season and failed to qualify for the NCAA meet.

Other men receiving recognition by the Emerald staff were football quarterback Bill Musgrave, golfer Tim Hval, wrestler Dan Vidlak, basketball player Keith Reynolds and tracksters Danny Lopez and Scott McGee.

Berry's teammate Stephanie Wessel finished second in women athlete of the year voting followed by softball player Julie Cavanaugh, basketball player Stefanie Kasperski, volleyball player Michele Krebsbach and tennis player Kumi Nagamoto.

Cavanaugh makes team

Oregon's junior first baseman Julie Cavanaugh was named to the second team all-America squad by the National Softball Coaches Association.

Cavanaugh, a Salem native, led the Ducks in six batting categories, including average with a .351 mark.

An all-conference selection the last two seasons, Cavanaugh led the team and was among the conference leaders in hits (66), runs (32) and triples (3) while maintaining the team lead in stolen bases (15).

Cavanaugh helped the Ducks advance to the NCAA Tournament the past two years, moving to first base from catcher midway through this season due to a hand injury.

The first team was dominated by Pac-10 teams with five selections. Pitchers Lisa Longaker of UCLA and Michelle Granger of California were picked along with outfielders Yvonne Gutierrez of UCLA and Vivian Holm of Arizona. Lisa Fernandez of UCLA was the first-team selection as a utility player.
