Concert worker shot near PLC

The following is a list of campus-area crimes taken from Eugene Police Department and Office of Public Safety reports from May 31 to June 21:

Police Beat

• A production assistant for the Grateful Dead concert was shot on the corner of 14th Avenue and Alder Street by unknown assailants June 21. The man was walking home from Taylor's Tavern when he heard a loud noise and looked down to see his finger bleeding. After more shots were fired, the man

fell to the ground.

He was taken to Sacred Heart General Hospital, where he was treated for ricochet bullet wounds to his thighs, left index finger and chin. Four bullet fragments were also removed from his knee. EPD officers found five 9mm Luger casings at the scene, and are still investigating the incident.

• Unknown suspects smashed the back window of a 1984 BMW parked in the Bean Complex parking lot on June 2, causing \$300 in damage. The owner's checkbook was taken from the car's glove compartment.

• A resident of the University Inn left his room June 3 for five
