

Scaling the Butte

Spencer Butte summit offers panoramic view

The view from the top of Spencer Butte, the most prominent natural feature of Eugene's southern skyline, is well worth the hour-long hike to the sum-

The 2,062-foot butte, geologically known as a "basalt uplift," has been known as one of the best viewpoints around tled in the 1840s.

Spencer Butte was known as Cham-o-tee," or Rattlesnake Mountain, by the original Native American inhabitants of the Willamette Valley (though few rattlesnakes are seen there nowadays). The butte was later named for 19th-century Secretary of War John Spencer.

The area was made a park by the City of Eugene in 1938. The forests around the butte have never been logged, and the oldgrowth ecosystem is home to a diverse array of animals. Living among giant 200-year-old Douglas fir trees are blacktailed deer, racoons, rabbits, squirrels, and numerous species of birds, snakes and tree

Three-foot-wide sword ferns have adapted well to the shady landscape, as have many kinds of wildflowers, including orchids and lillies. A word of caution: Poison oak is also a thriving member of the forest community, so hikers should view the plant life of the park

cer Butte takes anywhere from 30 minutes to an hour. The trails can be steep, especially near the rocks at the top, but hikers of all ages can reach the top with little difficulty.

• The trail from 52nd Avenue and Willamette Street, which meets the Fox Hollow trail halfway, and runs a total of 2.8 miles to the top, is long but not as steep. Parking is available.

To preserve the park environ ment, hikers should stay on the trail. Overnight camping is prohibited, as are mountain bikes, fires of any kind, horses, and






