specialty stores (sporting goods, stereo equipment, etc.), and banks for all-around shopping convenience. The center is also home to Meier and Frank, Emporium, Lamonts, J.C. Penny's and Montgomery Wards. Bike trails lead from the campus area along the Willamette River directly to the mall.

Parks

• Alton Baker Park(7) is a large, grassy expanse located along the Willamette River, just west of Autzen Stadium. Numerous bike trails connect the park with campus, the stadium and the river. It's the perfect place for a game of volleyball, frisbee or just catching up on your tan.
• Amazon Park(11), 2700 Hilliard St., is home to a community swim center, bike and jogging trails and wide open areas

of hilly grass ideal for lazy fall afternoons.

• Rock climbing, bike trails, the Willamette River and one the best views of the city are found at Skinner Butte Park(8), on the north end of the city. Atop the butte is a spectacular view of downtown Eugene and its surrounding hills. A picturesque rock face on the west side of the butte is ideal for rock climbers, while the trail leading up the butte is a challenge on the way up and a thrill on the way down for cyclists. Bike trails entwine the park, running along the river and north toward Valley River Center.

Canoe Works

• The Canoe Works(1), located across from the University on Franklin Blvd., offers inexpensive canoe rentals for quiet trips down the Millrace. The ride takes you through duck ponds, past the University Inn

and toward the west side of campus. The trips are perfect for cozy picnics and relaxation.

Hult Center for the Performing Arts

• The Hult Center's Silva Concert Hall(2) plays host to nationally known pop, rock, jazz and classical performers throughout the year. The hall is also home to plays and ballet performances by the Eugene Ballet Company and the Eugene Symphony Orchestra.

Saturday Market

• The Eugene Saturday Market(3), located on the park blocks between Eighth and Oak Streets, hosts food, live entertainment and homemade arts and crafts unique to Eugene every Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Entertainment is provided by local musicians, adding a distinctive flavor to the market. Saturday market will remain open throughout the fall, until the weather becomes too cold.

ahead," he said. "We were known for our honesty; if not we would have never had the national acts."

Mulheim said he did not know how Dingman's apparent abandonment of the property would effect the bankruptcy proceedings. "Right now the Taylors' have possession," he said. "Technically they shouldn't have taken possession, but the law doesn't tell you what to do when the trustee abandons the property."

In the meantime, Eugene blues fans are left wondering who will fill in as a landing spot for local and out-of-town

blues musicians.

"There are a number of people who are scampering to pick up that slack," Fox said. "But there are not many venues that can assume what Taylor's has done. What this town needs is a larger room — about 400-500 people."

WOW Hall publicist, Mike Walker said the opportunity is open for any place to emerge as the home of the blues; however, the music lends itself to a tavern atmosphere.

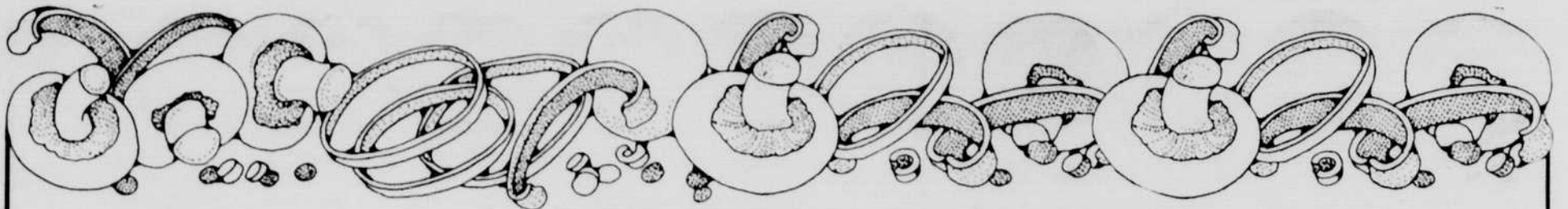
WOW Hall, 291 W. 8th Ave., will keep itself available to blues artists, Walker said. "We would welcome it, but it's hard to say if we could include it successfully in our program."

Walker mentioned Good

Times Cafe and Bar, 375 E. Seventh Ave., and The Butte Tavern, 211 Washington St., as spots likely to try and take advantage of the opportunity.

Plans for the old Taylor's building are currently up in the air. At the moment Taylor is in control of the building. However, in three years the lease reverts back to two of his sisters and will need to be renegotiated at that time.

Taylor said he is not interested in having another tavern in the building. And whoever he leases the building to will have to make repairs and do some remodeling to update the structure. He said he would rather see any new operators use the building as a coffee shop.

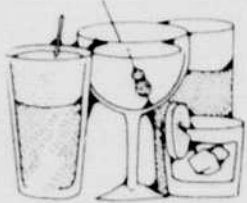
