The Museum of Art of is open from noon to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Sunday.

A second museum at the University, the Museum of Natural History at 1680 E. 15th St., will present two major exhibits during fall term.

"Masks and Monsters, Temples and Towers: The Golden Age of Mayan Architecture," will feature the life work of University Professor Emeritus George Andrews.

Andrews has been documenting Mayan ruins in the Chenes, Puuc and Rio Bec regions of Mexico for 30 years, said exhibit designer Margie Moreno.

He has made detailed pen and ink drawings which "capture the spirit and complexity of one of aboriginal America's most sophisticated civilizations," Moreno said.

"He has done extensive graphic work, recon-

structing the ruins in his drawings," Moreno said.

The second exhibit is titled "Ethiopia's Braided Traditions," and will feature everything from icons and magic scrolls to pottery, sculpture, costumes and paintings from the country.

"People will be able to see the cultural influences that have shaped (Ethiopia)," said University graduate student Cynthia Gabai, who organized the exhibit.

"There are Jewish, Islamic and Christian traditions as well as tribal traditions," Gabai said.

The collection was donated to the University by Oregon resident Jayne B. Hall, whose late husband, William O. Hall, was ambassador to Ethiopia during the 1960s and '70s.

The Museum of Natural History is also open from noon to 5 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. Group tours can be organized by contacting the museum at least two weeks in advance, Moreno said.
