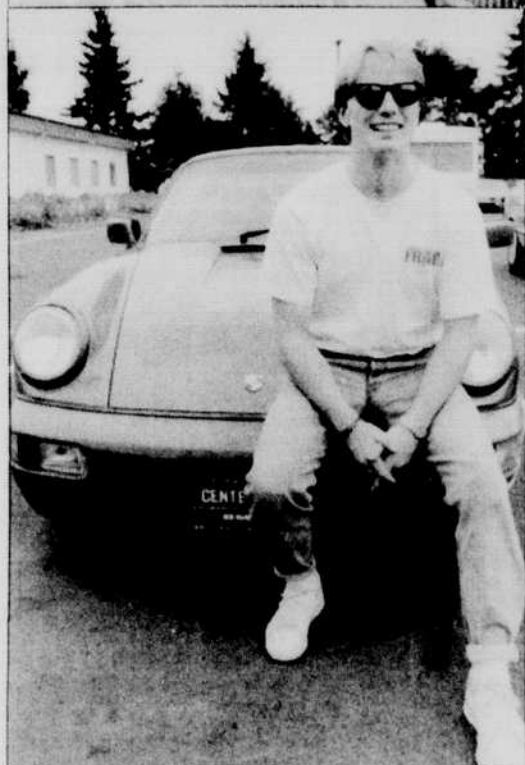


Kirk Bailey: Up Close and Personal

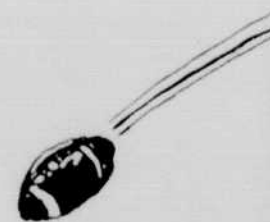

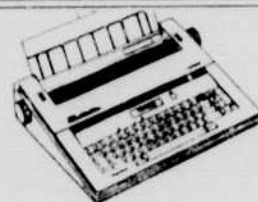
