Student athletes of all abilities will find an abundance of programs offered this fall through the parks and recreation departments of Eugene and Springfield.

Willamalane also offers open gym at the Memorial Building and at other locations throughout Springfield.

Beginning Oct. 1. Willamalane will host open gyms on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays primarily for University students. Admission to open gyms is free.

Health fitness programs are also available, with both water aerobics and regular aerobics offered for people 18 and older.

The water aerobics classes are held in the two Willamalane swimming pools.

The Lively Park Swim Center at 6100 Thurston Road in Springfield offers the only wave pool west of the Mississippi, Gerlach said. The pool also includes a slide, a whirlpool and a lap swimming area.


