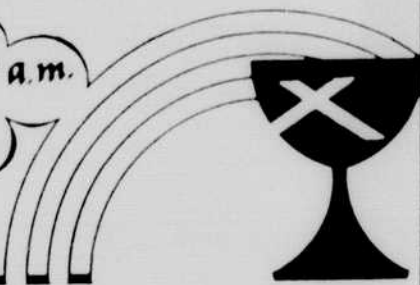

Employment available for students knowing where (and how) to look

Arrgh! The despair of job-searching begins for students who do not qualify for work-study and who have not made prior arrangements.

But there is hope, if the 12 temporary-service agencies, 14 employment agencies, and four employee-leasing agencies listed in the telephone book yellow pages are any indicator.

Add to the list other job search services such as the University's Career Planning and Placement Service and the State Employment Division.

About 67 percent of the 7,565 employers in Lane County are in Eugene, and 15 percent in Springfield, said Ken Rocco, state labor economist.

While there are many potential employers and jobs in the area, people who are not perpetual "pavement pounders" may find some pointers helpful in finding a temporary means to earn money.

"The college students need to fill out a job-search application and watch the job board," said Carol Fairbourn, state employment service supervisor.

"There are going to be a lot of business gearing up for Christmas help and they start doing that pretty early."

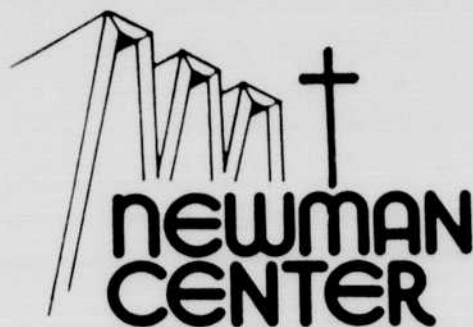
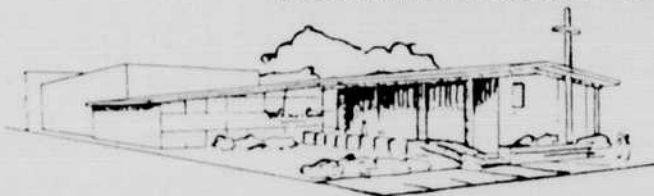
