For people who want to work part-time, Fairbourn suggested companies such as Harry and David of Medford, which has a telemarketing office in Eugene.

"There is a lot of part-time work out there in retail sales, fast food and the service industry, which includes motels," Fairbourn said. "All these agencies are having difficulty filling those positions."

While flipping burgers or changing beds does not sound exciting, Fairbourn especially recommended the work to stu-

dents new to the area who do not have local references for better jobs.

Students should start looking early, be flexible, have a fixed schedule, a car and a telephone to find part-time work successfully, said Dennis Murphy, who matches people with part- and fulltime jobs at Express Personnel Service.

In an area where jobs, especially professional jobs, are not plentiful, Murphy said students should get a feel for the hours required of a job before registering for classes in order to meet

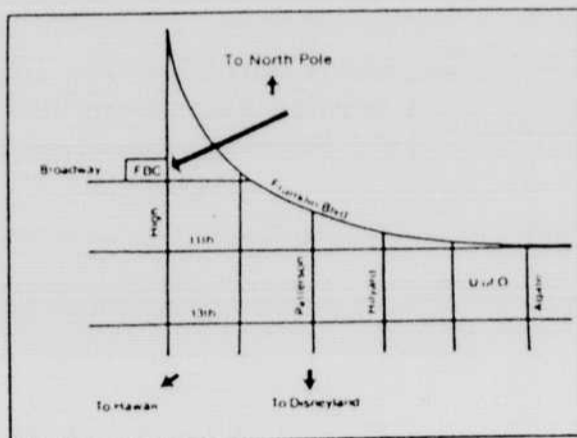
