## Hearing on proposed rule changes slated for Tuesday

A hearing dealing with amendments to nine University rules concerning skateboards, bicycles, student directory information, child care and contested student conduct cases will be held Tuesday, Oct. 2.

The hearings, which are being held in the EMU Gumwood Room, will begin at 1 p.m. and continue through the afternoon (one mid-afternoon break is scheduled), with the last hearing beginning at 4:30 p.m.

Hearings on rule changes occur "whenever they affect the lives of students," said Murial Jackson, assistant vice-president for Administration and presiding officer at the hearings

"I have found that it is in the

best interests of the campus to hold hearings on rule changes." Jackson said.

The schedule is as follows: Release and restriction of directory information, the most controversial issue according to Jackson, will be discussed at 1 p.m


The new program software to
