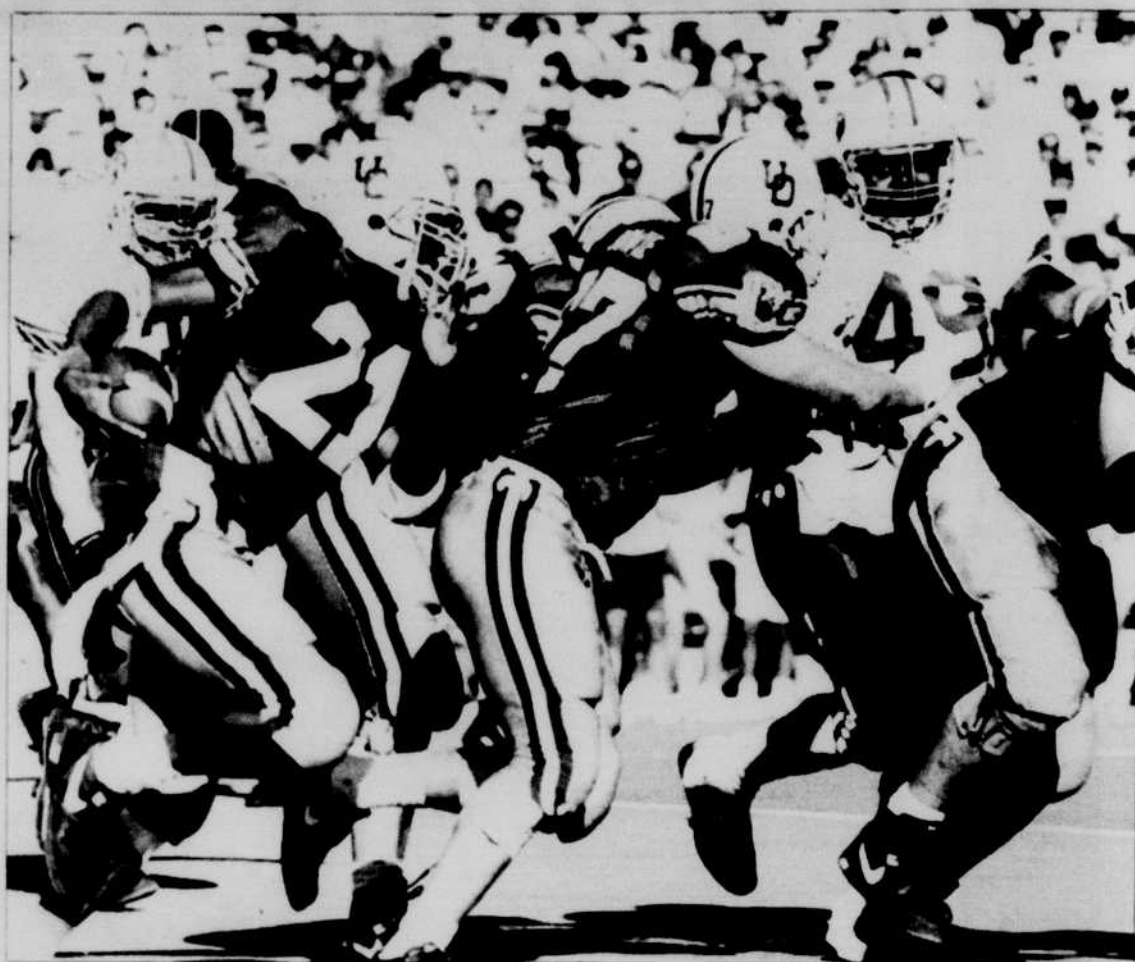

## Burwell runs into spotlight

Sean Burwell has tried to forget all about Derek Loville this season and has Oregon football fans already forgetting about Loville.

That doesn't mean to say that Burwell doesn't have a great deal of respect for the Ducks' all-time leading rusher and scorer, but with Loville now playing for the Seattle Seahawks, Burwell hasn't given much thought to replacing the best back in school history.

"Derek's gone and he's in the pros and I'm here," Burwell said. "I really haven't thought that much about it."

Last spring the Oregon coaching staff thought about it, thought about it a lot. After all, it's not every day that you lose a Loville. Latin Berry and Dondre Bausley to graduation. And without a good running game this season the coaches knew opponents would come after record-setting quarterback Bill Musgrave on every play.

"It's vital for any team to have a good running game, not just our team," running backs coach Gary Campbell said.

Burwell redshirted last season and came into spring drills behind sophomore Ngalu Kelemeni for the starting tailback position, but a strong spring camp and an impressive fall performance earned Burwell the starting job.

While everyone else might have been thinking Burwell was under the gun and in a pressure situation, he said it wasn't anything like that.

"We have no real pressure except to learn the offense," he said. "No one really said anything about pressure except the people interviewing me and wanting to know if I could try and replace Loville."

"It's funny about replacing Loville because I don't think about that," Burwell said. "I think more of the team and what we're trying to do."

Burwell has been a major part of what the Ducks are try-

ing to do this season, and a major reason for the team's success.

Oregon is off to a 3-1 start and ranked 22nd in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll after a convincing 32-16 victory over Brigham Young. Burwell has been the leading rusher and scorer for the Ducks as well as an outstanding receiver out of the backfield in the first four games.

Burwell has already rushed for 345 yards and four touchdowns and caught eight passes for 89 yards and another score. He is third in the Pacific-10 Conference in rushing and tied for fifth in scoring.

He's done all that after an inauspicious debut against San Diego State where he rushed for 38 yards on 12 carries. Since then, he has gained 126 yards against Idaho, 77 yards on 19 rushes against Arizona and, last week, 104 yards against BYU.

Running inside is one thing Loville was always good at and Coach Rich Brooks said that although Burwell has a long way to go in that area, he has vastly improved since the season-opener.

"Certainly he's trying to become a tougher, hard-nosed inside runner which Derek Loville was tremendous at," he said, "and he has made great strides in that since the San Diego State game where he was running up in there a little too
