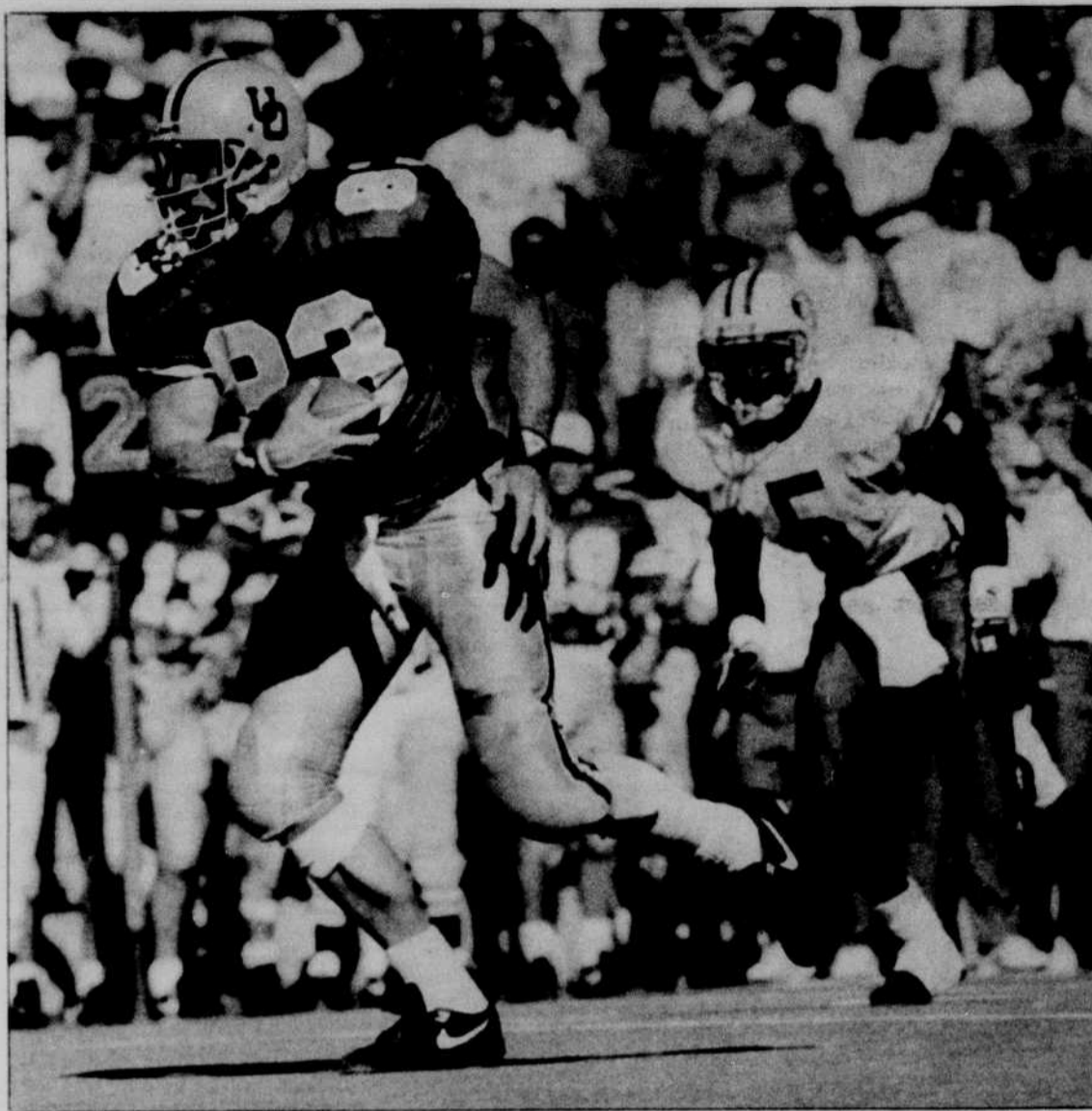

"I try to be a team person," he said. "It's more important than anything to be a team, because a

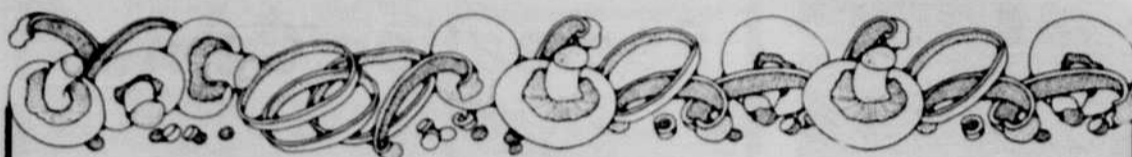
bunch of individuals will not get it done, but a team will."
