didn't lose anybody like we did against Idaho," Duck defensive coordinator Denny Schuler said.

Going into the Husky game healthy is something Schuler feels is going to be a key. Linebacker Andy Conner, who missed the Utah State game, is expected back for the Washington game.

"If we get Andy back we'll be healthy," Schuler said. "I think we're starting to jell at the right time."

With the Aggies in their rear view mirror, the Ducks can now set their sights on Washington. Oregon's loss to Arizona looms big because it leaves the Ducks with an 0-1 record in Pacific-10 play, making the Husky game a do-or-die situation for the Ducks' Rose Bowl hopes.

"I think if we're going to be in the Rose Bowl race we have to go to Seattle and win," Brooks said, "That's a tough assignment, but if we start off 0-2 in the conference our legitimate Rose Bowl hopes are pretty well over."

The 17th-ranked Huskies will be a formidable opponent for the surging Ducks. Washington, fresh off a 42-14 workmanlike victory over Arizona State, is 2-0 in conference play and 4-1 overall

"They (Washington) are an outstanding football team," Brooks said. "They don't have weaknesses."


Schuler, who spent a great deal of time during the off-season preparing game plans for Arizona, BYU and Washington, feels that Washington and its multi-dimensional offense will be a tougher test than either Arizona or BYU.

"They are going to test us in a lot of areas," Schuler said. "They do a very nice job running the football and they have a quarterback that will present a lot of problems for us."

The Husky attack features running back Greg Lewis, quarterback Mark Brunell and a mammoth offensive line, not to mention a defense that leads the nation in stopping the run.

"Their defense is playing as well as anybody on the coast," Schuler said.

Last year's 20-14 Husky win left a sour taste in the mouths of some of the Ducks players. The Ducks turned the ball over seven times in Seattle last year and blew several chances late in the game to pull out the victory.
