good football.

The 1980s saw the Huskies battle powerful USC and UCLA for control of the Pac-10 Conference. The Dawgs rumbled through the decade with an 84-33 overall record, two conference titles, nine bowl appearances and victories in five different bowl games.

Reitzug said Washington's success is part of the reason that the rivalry has grown between these two teams.

"The Huskies have had success on the national level," Reitzug said, "and since our program is trying to achieve some national recognition, the Washington game is very big."

The Huskies have dominated the series with the Ducks, winning 10 of the last 13 games, but they have lost two of the last three to the resurgent Ducks. Oregon hopes to continue to turn the

tide with a victory this weekend in Seattle.

"They've fairly well owned the series in the past, we'd just like to make a dent in it once in awhile," Brooks said.

Two of those dents came in 1987 and 1988 at Autzen Stadium. In 1987, freshman quarterback Bill Musgrave threw two touchdown passes to lead Oregon to a 29-22 victory and, one year later, Duck wide receiver Terry Obee scored on a 5-yard end-around play with less than two minutes to play to secure a 17-14 Oregon victory.

Reitzug and the other seniors hope to capture their third victory over Washington in four years, something that few Oregon players have accomplished in recent years.

"They always think they are so much better than us," Reitzug said, "but lately we've been as good or better than them. This is a really big game for both teams, but they don't like to admit that this game is big because they don't want to give us any credit."
