Sportsmanship prevails this time in Duck loss

Any sportswriter covering the Oregon-Washington game in Husky Stadium on Saturday noticed a dramatic difference from last year's game between the two Northwest rivals that also took place in Seattle.

It wasn't the difference in the score, either. Granted, the Huskies totally dominated the game and won 38-17, while last year's game was a defensive struggle and the Huskies won 20-14 by capitalizing on seven Duck turnovers. However, everyone remembers last year's game as having the heated atmosphere commonly associated with the intense rivalry.

Oregon players were taunted by the Huskies in the tunnel leading from the lockerroom to the playing field. Several Washington players were known to have chanted "Our house, our house" after the game and players from both teams had to be restrained from going after one another.

Even on the field, things were heated. An apparent fumble by Oregon's Ngalu Kelemeni on a kickoff that seemed to be anything but a fumble, led to a shoving match that the officials had to step in and stop.

It was a game that left neither team with much respect for the other.

Things seemed more serene and peaceful this time around, though. The rivalry still had the same intensity, and it was a great defensive struggle for two-and-a-half quarters before the Oregon defense was simply worn down by the Washington offensive line.

But after the game, players and coaches from both sides didn't quibble about poor officiating or how much they hated one another. Instead there were compliments flying around the post-game interview areas like bodies were flying earlier on the turf.

It seems that the two teams had newfound respect for one another afterward.

Oregon split end Joe Reitzug, a Tacoma native who knows something about Husky tradition, said Washington was a much better team this year and

probably the best team he's faced while at Oregon.

"Last year I didn't think they were quite as intense and focused as they are this year," he said. "They know what they're doing. It's going to be really tough for anybody in the Pac-10 to beat them, I think."

"This is pretty much the best game anybody has played against us in a long time so my hat's off to the Huskies," Reitzug said. "They're a great team."

Indeed they are. It's a team with the top-rated rushing defense in the nation and the third-leading rusher in the country in Greg Lewis. Yet the Huskies are only ranked 13th in this week's Associated Press Top 25 poll.

"I think Washington should be ranked fairly high," Reitzug said.

Meanwhile, Oregon dropped out of the Top 25 as Reitzug thought would happen although the Ducks lost to a team ranked higher than they were.

Maybe the rest of the nation could take a cue from the class showed by both these teams Saturday and pay the respect that the Ducks and Huskies were paying one another Saturday.
