Volleyball team swept in Corvallis

CORVALLIS — Oregon's volleyball team was swept by Oregon State in a Civil War rematch Wednesday.

The Beavers dominated the Ducks in three games, 15-8, 15-12, and 15-6.

"Oregon State played very well tonight," said Oregon head coach Gerry Gregory. "They dug the ball really well, as they always do. We had a lot of opportunities in the first game, but we didn't score. We spun our wheels and got frustrated with our dug ourselves some holes we couldn't get out of."

"Even though it was a three-game match, and the scores maybe weren't indicative of a close match, it was a long three-game match. Oregon State was clearly the better of

the two teams tonight."

The Beavers jumped out to an early lead in the first game, and stayed there. The Ducks attempted to catch up, but the closest they got was when they trailed 11-8 in the first game.

In the second game, Oregon State was crushing the Ducks and had a sizable lead, but Oregon would not die. The Beavers led 14-4, but the Ducks stormed back and cut the lead to two.

As in the first game, however, Oregon State led wire-to-wire, winning 15-12.

"I was proud of our comeback in game 2 when we came on like gangbusters," Gregory said. "We just need to start earlier and eliminate the free points we gave up."

The Ducks began the third game leading 3-1, but the Beavers took the lead back, were not really threatened again and

won the match.

"We didn't start out strong and it didn't carry through the match," said Oregon middle blocker Mindee Adams, who led the Ducks with 12 kills and 19 digs.

"Hopefully, we'll be able to help ourselves again," Adams said, adding that Friday's match against Portland State at McArthur Court "will be a challenge."

"I'm really pleased to win the match, and to win it in three games is great," said Beaver head coach Guy Enriques. "I figured we were in for a barn burner."

Middle blocker Dawnn Charroin and outside hitter Julie Jeffery both added 11 kills to the Ducks' effort. Outside hitter Julie Leamon led the Beavers with 15 kills and 10 digs.

Walters said. "The weight of the property tax is crushing the average tax payer."

But Hill said "to simply restrict spending without supporting some other equitable revenue source from the state would solve only half the problem."

Beyond the issue of property taxes, Walters and Hill take differing views on the state's spending limit.

"I believe that we have already spent beyond the limit," Hill said, calling the limit an "artificial barrier."

"Faculty salaries just won't be raised if we don't go beyond the limitation; it is the only way to solve the problem," Hill said.

But Walters disagrees. "We have more important problems to deal with. We should concentrate on our 'tax hell' problems," he said, adding that Oregon should be able to live within its budget.

"If the professors want better salaries they should leave and teach at N.Y.U. or Harvard," he said.

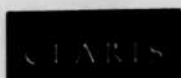

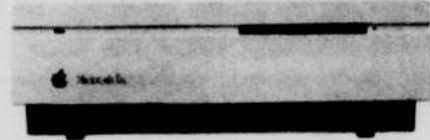

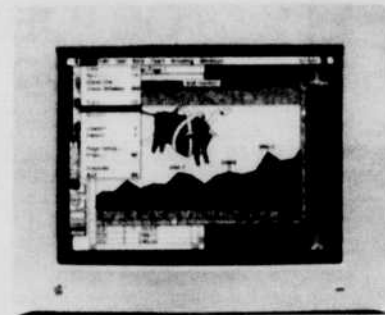
