"Becky would have been one of you," she added. "She would be in college, she would be 19 now."

"The inspiration that keeps us going is standing before us today," William Bell told the students.

The Indiana law allows a minor to seek an exemption by appearing before a judge. Oregon's Ballot Measure 8 does not include such a provision.

"The law proposed here is much more punishing than the

one in Indiana," William Bell said.

"As painful as it is to stand here, I have to tell you measures 8 and 10 have to be defeated," he said. "because we fear other Becky Bells will happen. Take a day out of your life, a day off work to volunteer at the polls to educate people as to how punishing these laws are."

"Please fight for it," Karen Bell said.

"This is not just a woman's issue," her husband said. "It's an issue that all people have to understand and take action on."

bear some of the tax burden.

"I understand the people's frustration," he said. "but there are better ways to handle this. My priority has been property tax relief, but this is a bad measure."

Beyond the property tax issue, Dwyer said he is against any governmental interference with a woman's right to choose to have an abortion.

"They (abortion opponents) have created this hysterical hype about the sanctity of life," he said. "They say they're good people, but they could use their resources to help feed and clothe starving children in this country."

Two measures on the Nov. 6 ballot would limit abortion rights in the state. Measure 8 would limit abortion except in cases of rape, incest or to save the life of the mother, and Measure 10 calls for parental notification at least 48 hours before a minor could receive an abortion.

Dwyer said he is against both.

"It violates the separation of church and state," he said. "I don't think the government should start interfering with the choices of people who bear children."
