By continuing to start and maintain companies in South Africa, and by not enforcing sanctions against the government, the United States has led the capitalist nations of the world in maintaining the system of apartheid, Meer said.

However, with events such as the release of African National Congress leader Nelson

Mandela, all South Africans have entered a new phase. Meer said although no real changes had occurred since his release, the system of apartheid is ready to be dismantled.

"Please keep up your support for the sanctions." Meer asked the audience. "It will help South Africa and the world as a whole."

After the lecture. Bheki Dlamini, a South African student from Swaziland, led the audience in singing a South African anthem blessing Africa and asking for peace in the
