Defense sends message to Green

Stanford Coach Denny Green might want to rephrase what he had been saying about the Oregon defense all last week because, after the Ducks' 31-0 defensive suffocation of the Cardinal on Saturday afternoon, nobody is going to take him seriously if he doesn't.

Green, who now owns a 5-14 record in his second year at the Stanford helm, was quoted during the past week as saying that although he thought Oregon was a good defensive football team, he didn't believe they were as physical as some of the other teams the Cardinal had faced — such as Colorado, Washington and Notre Dame.

Green may have been right about the first part of his statement, but he's dead wrong about the Ducks not being physical. Just ask Oregon inside linebacker Joe Farwell.

Farwell, who at 210 pounds looks more like a halfback than a linebacker, collected 13 tackles Saturday and said the comments by Green didn't slip by unnoticed.

"Coach (Rich) Brooks reminded us of that before the game," Farwell said. "Oregon is a physical football team and they better be ready when they play us."

Just like they did against Brigham Young, Oregon's defense answered the opening bell with a flurry and never let up on the way to their first shutout since a 49-0 blanking of Long Beach State at the beginning of the 1988 season.

Stanford had five possessions during the first period and each one ended with a punt. The Cardinal ended the quarter with 15 yards of total offense on 15 offensive plays, and Stanford made only one appearance in Oregon territory.

The Ducks held the Cardinal offense in check all day, allowing Stanford only 101 yards rushing and 197 yards passing on 21 completions.

Maybe now Green should ask his players if they think Oregon is as physical as somebody like Notre Dame or Colorado, or even Washington.

After all, Stanford ran over and through the Irish for a 36-31 win at Notre Dame and

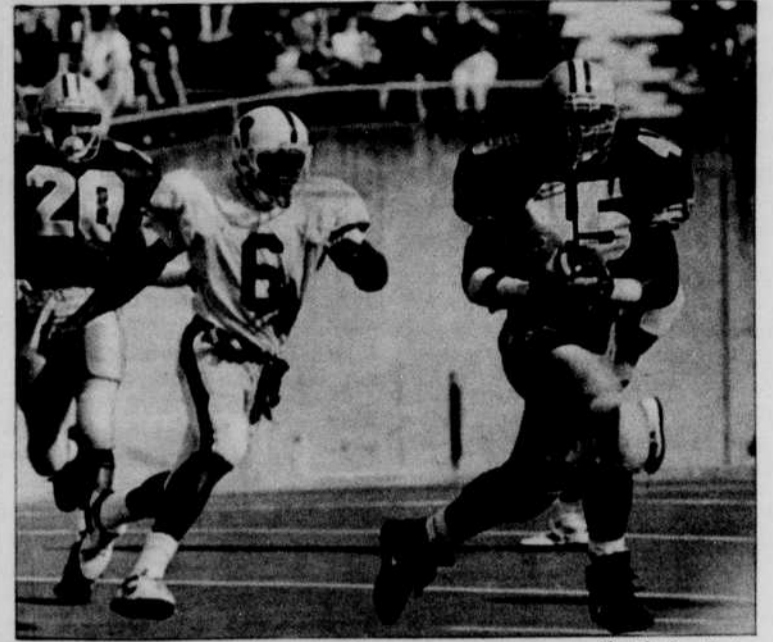

led Colorado on the road until the final minute of the game. And yet they couldn't even get inside Oregon's 34-yard line the entire day, unless of course they were covering one of Paul Stonehouse's 11 punts.

Not even Washington's "Purple Haze," considered by many to be the most physical defensive team in the nation, could throw a shutout at the Cardinal in their 52-16 rout last week.

Cardinal quarterback Jason Palumbis, playing in front of friends and family in his home state, didn't have the type of game that Oregonians came to expect from him during his days at Lakeridge High School in Lake Oswego.

He finished the first quarter with five completions in eight attempts for a whopping four (no, that's not a misprint) yards. Most of his success in the quarter involved the multi-talented Glyn Milburn, who caught three passes for one yard.

The shutout was something that nobody really expected, but the Ducks were not about to let go of one once it began to appear possible.

"We want shutouts against Utah State and teams like that," nose tackle Marcus Woods said. "We never really

expected it against a team like this."

Woods and Farwell received a lot of help from free safety Eric Castle and junior-college transfer Devon Hosey in leading the charge against the Cardinal.

Castle, a sophomore making only his sixth career start for Oregon, played center field for the Ducks all afternoon making nine unassisted tackles and assisting on seven others. He continued to draw praise from both Brooks and defensive coordinator Denny Schuler for his outstanding play.

"Eric Castle is a great football player in anybody's league anywhere," Brooks said. "He saves us a lot back there."

"So many times it looks like somebody is going to break one," Schuler added, "and then here comes Castle out of right field to make the hit."

Hosey, playing in only his second game of the year, made his second career interception one to remember by racing 76 yards for a touchdown that all but sealed the game.

That makes it two weeks in a row that the defense has scored as many, or more, points than the opposition. Not bad for a team that isn't very physical.

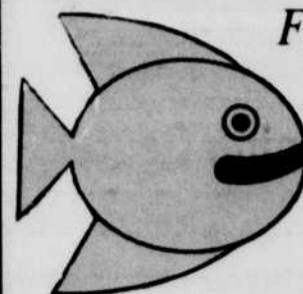
