That's what you will see if you happen upon Pegasus Smokehouse Pizza, 790 E. 14th Ave., on Halloween night. The faces don't belong to people, but they are the creation of a group of local artists and students who were just looking for something fun to do on a Sun-

Those grinning faces will be the outcome of Pegasus' pumpkin carving contest. "We are doing it just for fun, it's a gas," said Pegasus owner/manager Robert Henderson.

There is a \$25 prize for the best pumpkin and so far there are some good ones.

There is a Bart Simpson pumpkin, with bulging eyes, husk hair and a sign which reads 'No way dude!' There is also a pumpkin with yellow hair and green earrings, not to mention all the creepy jack-o'-lanterns with insanely

This is the first pumpkin carving contest for Pegasus', which opened a little over a year ago. "Some of the people in the neighborhood suggested the contest," said Henderson. "Old Max's used to do it, so I thought we'd give it a go."

Henderson is always willing to try something new or recycle an old idea. Opening a pizza place was not something Henderson had been planning to do. "I didn't come in with a concept.

"I had never made pizza before, but I had been smoking (food) for years." Henderson decided to open a pizza place, despite the number of pizza esdent population.

So Henderson set out to open a quality smokehouse pizza place. "Our goal is to make a better pizza. We use the freshest ingredients and try to purchase local produce whenever possi-

dough daily and the tomato sauce is cooked for a minimum of 24 hours.

Quality and variety rank high on Henderson's priorities. A quick look at the menu will show one of the largest varieties of pizza toppings available in town. Barbecue chicken, smoked salmon, smoked oysters, fresh pesto and a wide variety of fresh vegetables are just some of the specialities of the house.

Besides trying to buy produce locally, Henderson also concentrates on local beers. All but two of the beers on tap are Oregon beers. Henderson has been working on expanding his microtablishments already serving the stu- brew selection; currently he has five and will soon be moving up to nine.

To diversify the atmosphere he also remodeled the basement, which has a pool table, big screen TV and beer on tap. "The basement is more of a sports environment," Henderson said.

Now with the 21-and-over basement and the general restaurant atmosphere of the upstairs, Pegasus caters to all kinds. Especially to people who like quality pizza.


