OSPIRG hotline assists renters

The Incidental Fee Committee allocated \$997.24 to itself at its Oct. 25 meeting to prepare for upcoming budget hearings. It also established Nov. 30 as the starting date for budget hearings for the 1991-92 school year.

At its Oct. 18 meeting, the committee allocated \$235 to the *Oregon Voice* to cover installation of a new phone. And in other business, it approved internal line item transfers of \$20 and \$304.

OSPIRG's consumer hotline

is now open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. University students who staff the hotline can answer questions about tenant rights and landlord disputes.

"The consumer hotline is one of the few resources in the state from which renters and landlords can get information about their legal rights," said Derek Top, a student coordinator at the hotline.

dents for \$2 (\$4 for general public) in the OSPIRG office, EMU Suite 1.

Three University professors have been added to the list of Fulbright scholars teaching and doing research abroad in the 1990-91 school year.

Bruce Barnes, a mathematics professor, is in Athens, Greece, awaiting a new assignment after political upheaval changed his original post in Jordan.

Sarah Jane Klinghammer, an instructor in the American English Institute and the linguistics department, is teaching English at Charles University in Prague, Czechoslovakia, and developing materials for that university's applied linguistics department.

Decision sciences Professor **Kenneth Ramsing**, also dean of the University's Graduate School for the past three years, is spending 10 months in Bangkok, Thailand, studying that nation's industrial development. He has also received a John F. Kennedy Visiting Scholar Award.

Two other University professors received Fulbright awards earlier this year. They are **Leslie Steeves**, assistant professor of journalism, and **Alexandra Bond**, associate professor of theater arts.


Sally Wagner and **Lisa Nelson**, graduate students in the College of Business Administration's master's program in industrial relations, have each been awarded a \$1,500 scholarship funded by the Weyerhaeuser Company.
