## Ducks fly south to face Arizona volleyball teams

Oregon's road to the NCAA volleyball tournament heads through the valley of the sun this week beginning with a Thursday night match against

Arizona State followed by a Friday night tilt with Arizona. The Ducks currently reside in sixth place in the Pacific-10 Conference with a 5-7 confer-

ence mark and an overall record of 14-9 after being swept at home last weekend by USC and UCLA. If the Ducks are to bounce

back and earn a spot in post-season play, they will need to win both matches this week beginning with the Sun Devils on Thursday night.

Oregon isn't a very healthy team heading into the matches with three Ducks, including two starters, having suffered ankle injuries during the past two weeks.

Outside hitter Ali Watkins played in both matches last weekend on a sore ankle but should be near full strength this weekend. Reserve middle blocker Jennifer McGinnis sat out both games last weekend with an ankle sprain and is questionable for both matches.

Outside hitter Dawnn Charroin, who leads the Ducks in both kills and digs, sprained her left ankle near the end of the third game against UCLA on Saturday and is listed as probable for the two matches.

Arizona State enters the contest a one-half game behind Oregon in the conference standings with a 5-8 Pac-10 record and a 14-12 overall mark. The Sun Devils will be out to avenge a loss to the Ducks earlier this month at McArthur Court.

The Sun Devils are coming off a weekend in which they downed California and lost to Stanford, with both matches going four games. They are led by the strong arms of Mindy Gowell, Tina Berg and Kelly Plaisted.

Gowell's 4.65 dig average is sixth-best in the nation and her 4.1 average in Pac-10 games ranks her seventh in the conference. Plaisted ranks second in the conference with 4.2 digs a game.

Berg, the Sun Devils' 6-foot-3 senior middle blocker, is averaging a conference-leading 1.9 blocks a game.

Friday's match against Arizona will be a chance for the Ducks to try and even the season series with the Wildcats. Arizona knocked off the Ducks earlier in a five-gamer in Eugene.

The Wildcats, 15-9 overall and 6-6 in the conference, currently hold down fifth place in the Pac-10, a full game in front of the Ducks. They, like the Sun Devils, are fresh from a weekend that included a four-game victory over Cal and a loss to Stanford.

Senior outside hitter Terry Lauchner and setter Heather McCormack lead the Wildcat attack.

Lauchner is among the league leaders in kills, digs and ace average, while McCormack is averaging 12.4 assists a game, good enough for tops in the conference and seventh nationally.
