Anderson said. "But the nice

here in Eugene for myself."

On the other hand, Anderson has gotten something different out of the project. "For me, it was being able to set out on a venture that was risky.

"It's also important to me to be able to do non-profit shows." he said, referring to non-profit shows the two galleries are planning to exhibit after the first of the year.

But for now, White and Anderson are focusing all their energy on tonight and the galleries' opening exhibits.

Metro Arts' inaugural exhibition will feature the works of Suzanne Klotz, Mark Bulwinkle and Bill Berchou.

Next door, the Wm. White Gallery will be displaying the contemporary lighting fixtures of University bachelor of fine arts student John Thompson.

After opening night, the two galleries will be open daily from 11-4 p.m.
