## Brand will order hiring freeze if Ballot Measure 5 passes

University president Myles Brand will order a freeze on all University hiring and expenditures should Ballot Measure 5 be passed by voters in Tuesday's election.

If passed, the measure would limit property taxes to \$25 per \$1,000 of assessed value in 1991 and lower the limit to \$15 per \$1,000 over the next five years.

This cut would have a dramatic effect on funding the University receives from the state's general fund, resulting in a loss of \$30 million.

Brand also warned of tuition increasing two to three times as a result of the measure passing.

This would result in a lower enrollment and, therefore, a lower number of faculty members employed by the University, he said.
