

IFC to require on-time budgeting

All student-funded organizations must submit line-item budgets for the 1991-92 fiscal year, unless the Incidental Fee Committee votes otherwise, according to a resolution passed by the IFC at its Nov. 8 meet-

The groups most affected by this resolution will be larger organizations such as the Athletic Department and the EMU, which have not been required to submit detailed budgets in the past.

At the same meeting, the IFC resolved to zero-fund any group that does not submit its

ASUO budget package on time or that fails to properly notify the IFC that its budget will be submitted late.

The deadline for groups requesting less than \$5,000 in their budgets for next year is Thursday. Groups asking for \$5,000 or more must submit budget packages to the ASUO office by Dec. 6.

The resolution for line-item budgets was passed to "instill accountability to all studentfunded groups by allowing students to see where their money is going," Colson said.

The zero-funding resolution

is intended to streamline the budget process as well as improve accountability, he said.

In other business, the committee passed a third, nonbinding resolution asking all student-funded organizations to "make the best effort to make their services and events as accessible to all students as possible."

Colson said the third resolution was passed to encourage student groups to hold the majority of their events on campus, where the greatest amount of students can attend.
