right about keeping things in perspective when the baby was born.

"The main thing I tried to get across was that things are not going to come easy," Zoumboukos said. "I told him that he was going to have a baby at the toughest time of the season, and that things just don't take care of themselves."

Boatright has taken Zoumboukos' advise to heart.

"We talked about those things so there would be no surprises and I could focus," he said, "and

it has helped me a lot. So far it has worked out great."

While Boatright realizes the challenge of facing Tuaoalo this weekend, he remembers all too well the day, in 1988, that the Beavers finally beat the Ducks, and he doesn't want to see it happen again.

"I remember trying to finish the game (in Corvallis) with all of the fans ready to rush the field," he said about the loss that ended a 13-game Oregon winning streak in the Civil War. "I couldn't live with losing to (the Beavers) in my senior year. There is a lot of pride at stake, and we are going to play this game like we're both 9-0 and going for the national championship."
