and the overall sports program will benefit from access to it," Bowerman said.

Construction on the building will begin in January. The building will wrap around the northwest corner of Hayward Field where the bleachers located at the start of the 100-meter dash now stand.

The building's location will help block out winds from the north, which have interfered in the past with the clocking of possible record times at Hayward Field.

Bowerman, the Ducks' track coach from 1948 to 1973, first proposed a track house in 1982.

but the former coach's dream fell through that year when relations between Bowerman and the University administration broke down. He again expressed his interest in the project in 1988, when Hayward Field was last renovated, but again nothing came of it.

Bowerman was a successful coach at Oregon, following Bill Hayward and preceding current men's coach Bill Dellinger.

Bowerman won five NCAA track titles at Oregon and coached 28 Olympians before giving over the program to Dellinger, a former world recordholder and three-time Olympi-

Bowerman earned a bachelor of science degree in business administration in 1934 and a master of education degree in 1953. He was on both the football and track teams at Oregon. He was also student body vice president and sports editor of the Oregon Daily Emerald.

Following his track coaching career at Oregon, he put his business degree to use by forming Nike with Phillip Knight.
