Duck football players honored

Three Oregon football players have been selected to the CoSIDA/District VIII GTE Academic All-America football team for Division I-A and I-AA players.

Quarterback Bill Musgrave, offensive guard Bud Bowie and linebacker Andy Conner have all been named to the 25-player District VIII team. District VIII comprises Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington and British Columbia.

By being named to the District VIII team, all three Ducks and the other 22 players are eligible for consideration for the CoSIDA/GTE Academic All-America teams.

Musgrave, a senior from Grand Junction, Colo., was an honorable mention All-American selection last season. Musgrave has a 3.46 grade point average in finance and will graduate at the end of fall term.

Musgrave holds every school passing record as well as all of the school's total offense records.

Musgrave was also the first team all-Pacific 10 Conference quarterback this season.

Bowie, a junior from Central Point, carries a 3.57 GPA in bi-

ology. Bowie also was named as one of the Pac-10/Big-10 winners of the Honda Scholar-Athlete award earlier this season.

Bowie was one of the most improved players on this year's football team. After being a non-letterman for the past two seasons, Bowie stepped in this year and started eight of 11 games for the Ducks at right guard.

Conner, a junior from Klamath River, Calif., has a 3.55 GPA in leisure studies and is minoring in Spanish.
