cessitating more classes in which students can enroll to fulfill the requirement. Holbo said.

Holbo also said the decision about which classes count toward the requirement is not done arbitrarily. There is a list approved by departmental faculty, followed by a review of the proposed class, before a class is cleared, he said.

"A teacher cannot just de-

cide to teach a class and it automatically fulfills a requirement," Holbo said. He added that the classes will eventually begin to filter

Holbo said there will be no special review of the requirements, outside of what ordinarily takes place after a new requirement is implemented.

Bailey said he would like to see a review take place now the requirement has been in effect for one term.
