The film will be shown in Russian without subtitles and is part of a winter term series of films sponsored by the Russian department and the Russian and East European Studies Center.

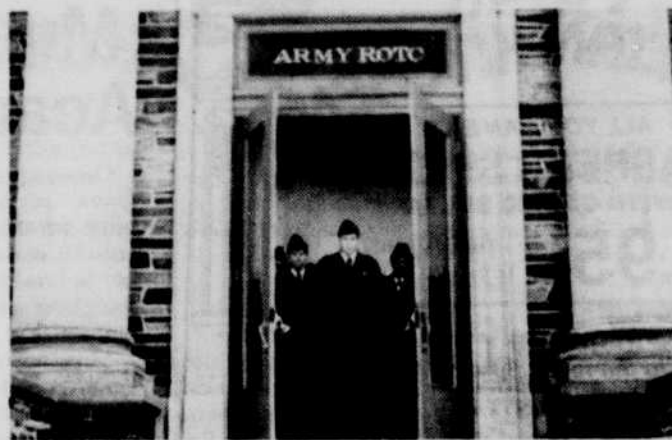
