Divided Legislature begins term

SALEM — The 66th Legislature began the 1991 session Monday with the swearing in of representatives and senators, choir performances and even a prayer.

In the early morning inauguration, the House bowed their heads in prayer and asked the Lord to give them the wisdom of Solomon to make the difficult legislative decisions in the 1991-93 session.

The state's 30 senators and 60 representatives were sworn into office as they pledged to uphold the constitutions of Oregon and the United States to

the best of their ability.

In doing so, they overturned the House Democratic majority, marking the first time in 20 years the Republicans have had control of the House.
