Oregon wrestlers pin BYU, 36-2

The Oregon wrestling express stopped in McArthur Court for a rare home meet Thursday, and the 7-0 Ducks celebrated their first night in front of the home crowd by steamrolling Brigham Young, 36-2.

"I thought it would be a closer match," said Oregon Coach Ron Finley, who watched his wrestlers jump to a quick 17-0 advantage with major decisions by Dan Vidlak, Pat Hirai, and Rob Stone, and a technical fall win by Scott Glenn.

"It really sets the tone." Finley said of the fast start. "And the situation is, a guy is almost afraid not to perform well because the whole team is performing so well."

Cam Strahm ended the meet on a strong note at heavyweight, with a 19-4 technical fall win over Scott Fannin.

"From Vidlak to Cam Strahm, they did a fine job all the way through," Finley said.

Vidlak, an all-American at 118 pounds, improved his record to 10-0 by beating Kelton Anderson, 16-5. Hirai followed with a 13-2 defeat of Robert Ho at 126, and Stone dominated Don Vantassell, 14-2, in the 134-pound bracke

Glenn's takedown of Rick Porter with 1:34 remaining in the third period gave Oregon a five-point technical fall in the 142-pound class and the big 17-0 advantage.

BYU's only points came at 150 pounds where the Cougars' Phil Armstrong fought to a 3-3 draw with Pat Craig, who was battling an injured knee suffered in practice Wednesday.


Curt Strahm continued his hot pace, using five takedowns to defeat Rick Evans in the 190 match, 13-6. Strahm's season record is now 18-1.

Other victories for the Ducks came in the 158-, 167- and 177-pound classes.

Thursday's win was Oregon's 18th straight dual meet win over two seasons. That record, and next month's Pacific-10 Conference meet, has the Ducks working harder to not only maintain that success, but try and improve as a team every meet out.

"We're wrestling really tough right now," Stone said. "I think our conditioning is paying off.

"We're ready for the stretch," he said. "We've got a month to prepare for the Pac-10s (conference championships)."
