The percentage would vary according to the field the business is involved in, Hallock said. For instance, retailers, who generate a lot of revenue, would pay at a lower percentage rate than a service business such as a law firm.

The benefits of this system include manageability, a relatively low tax rate, and stability as an income source. It is estimated that this tax would generate \$500 million for the state.

The problem with the tax is that it may hurt Oregon's business. Also, it could appear as a kind of sales tax that would be passed along to consumers as an extra cost.

Ken Tollenaar, interim director of the Bureau of Governmental Research, said he believes voters would prefer a sales tax over a gross receipts

"Gross receipts is not a new idea," he said. "(People) have to look at it as an idea beat down in the past, often by labor groups claiming it is recessive

It is estimated that a 6 percent sales tax would raise \$2.2 billion for the state.

Supporters of a sales tax proposal would have to overcome Oregonians' traditional opposition to such a tax and would have to counter arguments that it is regressive, meaning it poses more of a burden on lowincome residents than on wealthier taxpayers.

Hallock said she does not believe a sales tax alone would be enough to reform the tax system because it does not spread the tax burden equally between businesses and individuals.
