Bill before state legislators would cut salaries

State legislators' salaries would be reduced by 15 percent and would be tied to fluctuation in the state's average wage if a newly introduced bill is eventually passed.



The bill, announced last week by Rep. Rod Johnson, R-Roseburg, would set legislators' salaries at \$875 a month, and it would require their pay to increase or decrease at the rate of the annual average hourly earnings of production workers throughout the state.

"It is essential that we as a legislative body share in the pain being felt by the mill workers, secretaries, teachers and people of Oregon by reducing our own salaries." Johnson said. "It is also important that we change the way our salaries are determined so we can better tie them to the working people of Oregon.

But Johnson's bill, which would begin with the next fis-

cal year on July 1, is only one of several salary-cutting ideas.

With Measure 5 budget cuts affecting all state programs, House Speaker Larry Campbell, R-Eugene, said Tuesday that the House Republican Caucus is considering a proposal to reduce legislators' salaries by 10 percent.

But when Senate President John Kitzhaber, D-Roseburg, was asked by reporters about the Democratic position on the issue, he said the Senate Democratic Caucus "is not interested

in cutting their salaries."

Members of the state Senate sent the first Oregon "Desert Fax" Thursday to soldiers in the Persian Gulf, wishing them 'safe and successful return.'

If passed in the Legislature. the bill would exempt Oregon soldiers participating in Operation Desert Storm from paying state personal income tax on the dollars they earn from the military. The legislation is similar to a federal tax break recently signed by President George Bush.
