Strahm also finished third at 190 pounds to return to the NCAA Championships.

Paul Keysaw of Cal-State Bakersfield defeated Strahm in Saturday's semifinals, but Strahm came back to beat Dwayne Butch of Fullerton State 11-5 in Sunday's semifinals and then hammered Fullerton State's Ray Raso 14-4 in the third-place finals.

Oregon also had three oth-

er wrestlers, Rob Stone (142 pounds), Mat Sprague (167 pounds) and Cam Strahm (heavyweight), all finish fourth. All three could still make it to the NCAAs as the conference coaches pick eight wildcard entries to go to the NCAAs. However, those results were unavailable at press time.

Pat Craig completed the scoring for the Ducks, finishing fifth at 150 pounds with a win and a loss Sunday, despite suffering a shoulder injury Saturday.
