# **Ducks take four from Huskies**

Greider, who coaches the Oregon women's tennis team, entered the match knowing that his team hadn't won a match from Washington in the last two seasons. He and his team left with four wins against the Huskies and a load of confi-

Andrea Pollock at fifth singles 6-4, 3-6, 6-2 before teaming with Tracey Miller to clinch the third doubles flight with a 1-6. 7-5, 6-3 win over Pollock and Susan Cahoon

Margaret Fraleigh, playing seventh singles, collected another Oregon win over Washington with a three-set triumph against Beth Hutton 6-2, 4-6,

Greider's squad plays at Portland Saturday before concluding its season by hosting both Washington and Washington State in the Pac-10 Duals on April 19-21.

## All-American Strahm wins wrestling MVP


Senior Curt Strahm, who had the fourth-most wins in Oregon wrestling history, was honored Sunday as the team's most valuable wrestler.


