## Cycling team to host Spring Criterium Sunday



The Club Sports cycling team will be hosting its traditional Spring Campus Criterium Sunday, with the race wrapping around the EMU.

The Club Sports cycling team is hosting the event along with Pedal Power Bicycles and Domino's Pizza. Nearly \$1,500 in cash and prizes will be awarded in three different competition categories.

The cyclists will follow a rectangular course around campus, starting on 15th Avenue and going to the University. From there, cyclists will go to 13th Avenue, to Agate Street and loop back around to the finish line on 15th. One loop is equivalent to one-half mile.

Novice competition for cyclists under 18 years old will be begin at 8:30 a.m. followed by

novice competition for those 18 and older at 8:45 a.m.

After the novice competition, men's and women's college races will take place. A men's "B," 30-minute-plus-two-lap race, will start at 9:15 a.m., and a women's competition, similar to the men's "B" race, at 10 a.m. A men's "A" race, covering 40 minutes plus two laps, will start at 10:45 a.m.

Club Sports coordinator Mark Landree said he has been planning the event for almost three months.

"It has been very difficult to get the kind of sponsorship we've wanted for the race in the past," he said. "But this year the word is already out about the prize list and the solid sponsors backing the event."

"I predict that this race will be the best one we've held in the last four or five years," Landree said.

Eugene City Club won the

tournament while a club team from Newberg was second. Oregon State's club team was third, and Bainbridge, Wash., was fourth, followed by Oregon and Washington State.

Oregon beat Bainbridge in its first game, 11-7, but was

topped 17-7 by Newberg, before beating Washington State 8-7 for fifth.

Raegan Bowles, Gigi Roga, Mikki Renzoni and Kathleen Thompson led the Oregon offensive attack in the tournament.

## Oregon golfers fifth; Tamiya places fourth

The Oregon men's golf team finished fifth at the Southwestern Intercollegiate Golf Invitational tournament completed Tuesday at Westlake, Calif.

The Ducks had a 54-hole score of 900 to finish just 22 strokes off first-place USC, which fired an 878. Rounding out the top five were UCLA, Texas-El Paso, Stanford and Oregon.

Oregon's Troy Tamiya finished fourth individually with a 217 with rounds of 71, 74 and 72, respectively. Tamiya finished only five strokes behind UTEP medalist Dave Bishop, who fired a 212.

Doug DuChateau and Jeff Lyons also had good tournaments for the Ducks, firing scores of 224 and 230, respectively. Cam Martin (233) and Paul Regali (237) rounded out the Oregon scoring.

The Oregon women's golf team remained in eighth place at the Sun Devil Invitational in Tempe, Ariz., after Tuesday's play. The tournament will conclude Wednesday.

San Jose State leads the team competition with a 36-hole score of 588 while the Ducks have 625 strokes.

Leigh Hornung led the Ducks Tuesday with a 76.
